Family Engagement Opportunity Grant

Family Engagement Opportunity Grants are opened to all legally operating organizations, agencies, child care providers, faith-based groups, and human and social service agencies, non-profits and for-profits within the state of Georgia who currently or will offer family engagement and educational opportunities for families with children birth to eight years old in one or more of the Early Education Empowerment Zones (E3Zs) and/or Metro Atlanta Counties specified by DECAL. Applicants can apply for up to \$15,000 for a one-year grant project. For more information, visit: www.decal.ga.gov.



E3Z Child Care Expansion Grant

The Department of Community Affairs is offering economic development incentive packages up to \$100,000 in counties located in Georgia's Early Education Empowerment Zones (E3Zs) to:

- Expand a current child care center
- Open a new child care center

Additionally, programs must be two or three Star Quality Rated and create two new full time jobs.

Eligible funding uses include salary subsidy payments and classroom equipment.
