Technology Funding



- \$500 per classroom
- Approval form was due: May 24th
- Funds expended & goods received by June 24th
- Reconciliation form was emailed from PANDA
 - Complete a paper reconciliation
 - Must be reconciled separately
 - Due to DECAL June 28th

Classroom Refurbishment Funds



- Eligible classes were identified and contacted in early May
- Approval form was due: May 24th
- Funds expended and goods received: June 30th
- Funds reconciled in the 2012-2013 Pre-K Year End Reconciliation Report completed in PANDA system
- Funds can not be carried over to FY2014

Pre-K Reconciliation for 2012-2013



- Completed in PANDA
 - Private programs due: August 31, 2013
 - Public programs due: September 30, 2013

Funding for 2013-2014



- Funding Timeline
 - Notifications for new and expansion classrooms will be sent out by the end of next week.

Notifications of class closures for low enrollment or quality issues have been completed.

FY 2014 Grant agreements will be emailed the first week in July.

2013-2014 Days of Service



- 180 Instructional Days or equivalent hours
 - 1170 hours of instruction
 - No waivers for instructional hours
- 8 Teacher Professional Development/ Planning Days
 - 3 days minimum
 - Must request a waiver if operating less than 8 planning days
 - Must meet lead and assistant teacher minimum salary
 - Lead Teacher 90% minimum
 - Assistant Teacher 100%
- For questions or request a waiver for planning days, contact assigned consultant.

- Guidelines will be posted online by July 1st
- Guidelines Changes:
 - Category 1 Eligibility Documentation:
 - Peach Care no longer qualifies as Category 1 documentation
 - Technology items were added to the Basic Equipment List eliminating the need for prior approval

 - All teachers, assistant teachers, and administrators trained on GELDS
 - GELDS Teacher Resource Book distributed to programs
 - November/December 2013: New list of approved curricula models posted (for 2014-2015 school year)
- School Year 2014 2015:
 - Full implementation in classrooms
 - Programs select from the new list of approved curricula models that provide best alignment with GELDS
