## PUBLIC NOTICE: CHILD NUTRITION PROGRAM STATE WAIVER REQUEST

## ALLOWING MORE THAN THE REQUIRED NUMBER OF MEALS TO BE SERVED PER CHILD PER DAY IN THE CACFP AT-RISK AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAM

In accordance with the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food Nutrition Services (FNS) policy memorandum, CACFP12-2018, SFSP05-2018 - Child Nutrition Program Waiver Request Guidance and Protocol-Revised, May 24, 2018, the Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning (DECAL) is seeking a waiver of statutory and/or regulatory Program requirements.

The Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning (DECAL) is requesting this waiver to allow more than the required number of meals to be served per child per day in the At-Risk Afterschool component of the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP).

Specifically, DECAL requests the following to be waived:
