To: All Sponsors participating in the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP)

RE: Information required by the Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act (FFATA)

The Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act (FFATA) was enacted with the intention to make government more accountable for each spending decisions. The end result is to reduce wasteful spending in the government. The FFATA legislation requires information on federal awards (federal financial assistance and expenditures) be made available to the public via a single, searchable website, which is www.USASpending.gov.

In order for all participating SFSP organizations, in agreement with Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning (Bright from the Start), to be compliant with this federal legislated act, the following information is now required on an annual basis:

1. Dun & Bradstreet Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS) number, which can be assessed for registering at: www.dnb.com/US/duns_update/
2. Zip Code + 4 address format
3. Five top compensated staff names and each person's total compensation (entire organization not just those involved with SFSP).

This requirement is now part of the annual SFSP application within CNP 2000. Failure to complete each required section of the SFSP application will impact the final review and approval of the application. Only Sponsors with an approved application can participate in the SFSP and submit claims for reimbursement.
