


## WSO How To: Check your Security settings in Internet Explorer

As shown in the below screen print:

1. Click on Tools.
2. Click on Internet Options.
3. Click on Security.
4. Click on Custom Level



When the 'Security Settings – Internet Zone' screen appears, scroll down making sure the Enable/Disable values match those shown below for the specific items listed below. I have not listed all items that you will see on your screen, but just those pertaining to the ActiveX settings.

-  ActiveX controls and plug-ins
  -  Allow previously unused ActiveX controls to run without prompting
    - Disable

  -  Allow Scriptlets
    - Disable

-  Script ActiveX controls marked safe for scripting\*
  - Disable

- Downloads
  -  Automatic prompting for file downloads
    - Disable
    - Enable
-  Use Pop-up Blocker
  - Disable
