RE: Notice of Revocation

Dear United States Corporation Agents, Inc. and Ms. Spear:

On April 26, 2011, your annual license fee for was due to Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning (Bright from the Start) and was not received by May 27, 2011. A late payment notice was e-mailed to you on April 27, 2011. Due to your failure to submit your annual license fee, your license to operate a child care learning center is no longer valid. The Georgia law for which you are being cited is marked as Exhibit "A" and incorporated in this Notice by reference.

Based on your noncompliance with Georgia law, you are hereby notified that your license to operate a child care learning center is revoked. Bright from the Start's legal authority for revoking the license is found in O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-10(m)(4), O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-12(b)(3)(4)(5) and Section 20-1A-12(c)(5).


In accordance with O.C.G.A. Sec. 20-1A.10(o), this revocation becomes effective thirty (30) days from receipt of this Notice. You have the right to appeal the decision to revoke your license to operate by filing a written request for an administrative hearing before an Administrative Law Judge with the Office of State Administrative Hearings. The request must be made in writing within ten (10) days of receipt of this Notice and addressed to:

A hearing request stays or suspends the revocation.

If you do not appeal this action within ten (10) days of this Notice or pay the balance of your license fee and late fee, the decision to revoke your license will be final. Revocation of your license or certificate of registration may impact your participation in the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP), Georgia's Pre-K Program, and Child and Parent Services (CAPS) subsidized child care program. The revocation process can be stopped by paying the balance of your license fee and any late fee. Licensure staff will conduct a follow-up visit to verify closure.
