RE: Notice of Revocation

Dear Mrs. Rusiecki:

During a follow-up visit conducted on October 13, 2011, at your family day care home located at 2841 Livsey Drive, Tucker, Georgia, 30084, it was determined that serious rule violations occurred which could have seriously affected the health and safety of the children in care and demonstrated an intentional and reckless disregard for the physical and mental health and safety of the children in care. Specifically, it was observed that you had thirteen children in care on October 13, 2011 and seventeen children in care on October 12, 2011. These rule violations were previously cited on September 27, 2011, May 6, 2011, and April 13, 2011. An office conference to discuss these rule violations with you was scheduled for October 4, 2011, at the Bright from the Start office, but you failed to attend, therefore the conference was conducted with you on October 13, 2011. The rule violations for which Bright from the Start is basing the revocation are marked as Exhibit "A" and the September 27, 2011, May 6, 2011, and April 13, 2011 visits are marked as Exhibits "B", "C", and "D", respectively, and incorporated in this Notice by reference.

Based on your noncompliance with Bright from the Start's Rules for Family Day Care Homes, you are hereby notified that the registration to operate your family day care home is hereby revoked. Bright from the Start's legal authority for revoking a registration is found in O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-12(b)(3)(5), and Section 20-1A-12(c)(5), and the Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning's Rules for Family Day Care Homes, Chapter 290-2-3 of the Official Compilation of the Rules and Regulations of the State of Georgia.

In accordance with O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-10(o) this revocation becomes effective thirty (30) days from receipt of this Notice. You have the right to appeal the decision to revoke your registration to operate a family day care home by filing a written request for an administrative hearing before an Administrative Law Judge with the Office of State Administrative Hearings. The request must be made in writing within ten (10) days of receipt of this Notice and addressed to:

1. Rule 290-2-3-.04(2) requires that any person that provides care for more than six children for pay shall make application to operate as either a Group Day Care Home or a Day Care Center.

During a monitoring visit conducted on October 13, 2011, there were thirteen children present in the family day care home. Nine of the children were kept for compensation. It was also determined that the provider had seventeen children in care on October 12, 2011. The provider had not submitted an application for license as either a group day care home or a child care learning center.

This rule violation was previously cited on September 27, 2011, May 6, 2011, and April 13, 2011.

The family day care provider's repeated failure to reduce to six children for compensation could possibly place the children at risk of harm.

2. Rule 290-2-3-.07(8) requires that the total number of children present under the age of thirteen years not exceed twelve.

During a monitoring visit conducted on October 13, 2011, there were thirteen children present in the home under the age of thirteen years.

This rule violation was previously cited on September 27, 2011 and April 13, 2011.

The failure of the family day care provider to not exceed twelve children present under the age of thirteen at one time could possibly place the children at risk of harm.
